In-home and school-based counseling services are available based on appropriateness and availability.

Our Professional Staff

Staff hold advanced degrees in psychology, social work and counseling and are licensed in Illinois. Clients who receive behavioral health services will have access to a full array of social services offered at Catholic Charities including: food pantry, benefit screening, and enrollment, homeless prevention funding, and WIC nutrition counseling.
